ACCESS Project - Against Crime: Care for Elders Support and Security (ZE4/ AG/2010/1576), financed within the framework of the EU programme "Criminal Justice", aims at identifying good practices and standards for improving capacities of Police Officers, Judges, Lawyers, Practitioners and other Operators who deal with elderly victims of crime.
